Publication of Sustainability Report 2013

Today sees the publication of Bucher Industries' sustainability report 2013. Prepared in

accordance with the G3 standard of the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI), the report

contains key figures on production, energy consumption, employees and suppliers.

The Group collected data relevant to the key figures at the 31 most important production sites

worldwide. These sites account for about 80% of Group sales and more than 90% of all

employees. Against the background of a 3% increase in Group net sales in 2013, the rise in

energy consumption was lower at 2%, while CO₂ emissions increased at the same rate as

sales. The key figures for employees showed little change. The GRI Index is published as a
