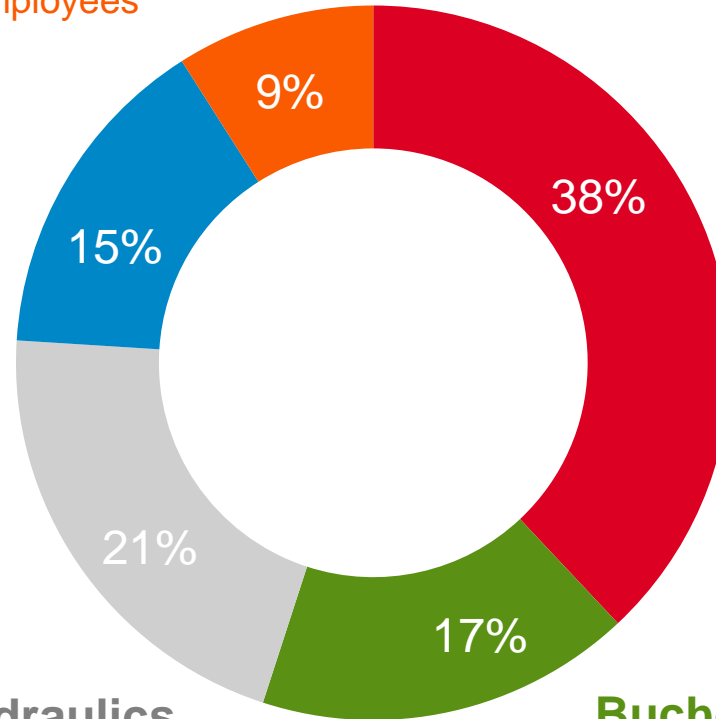

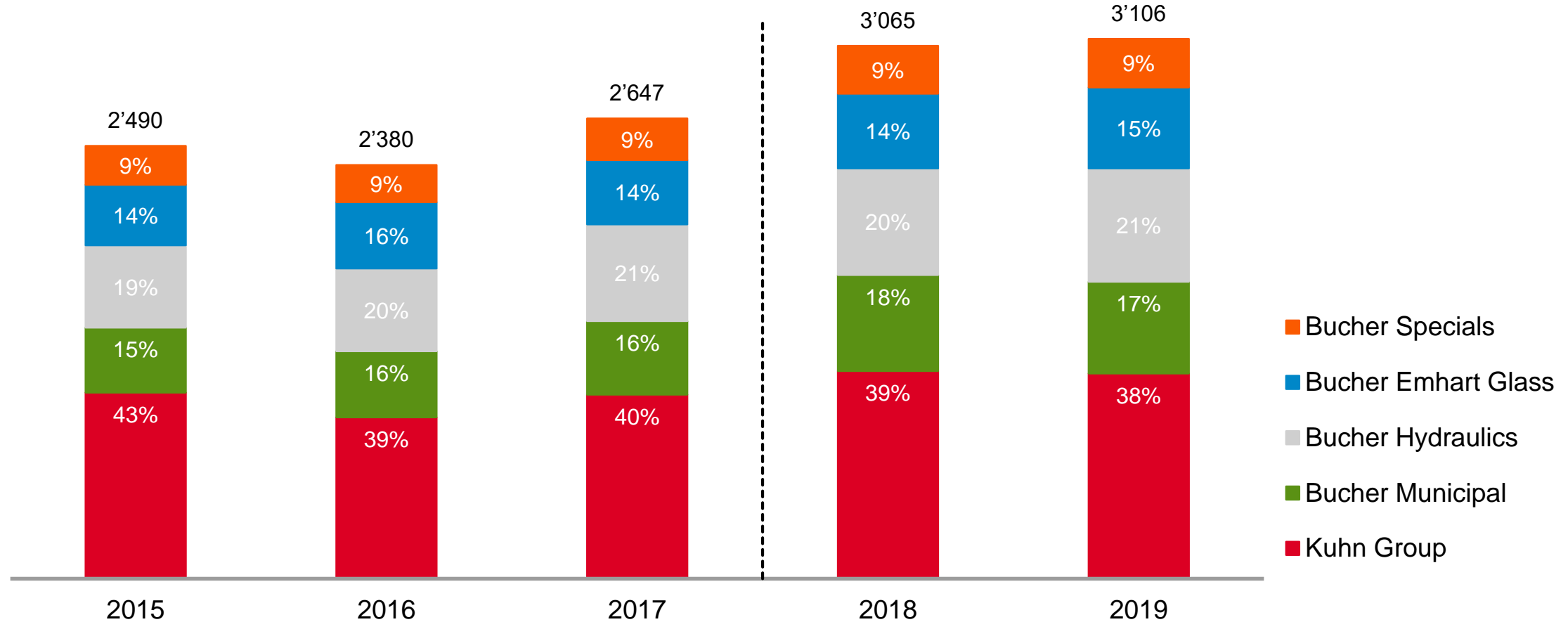

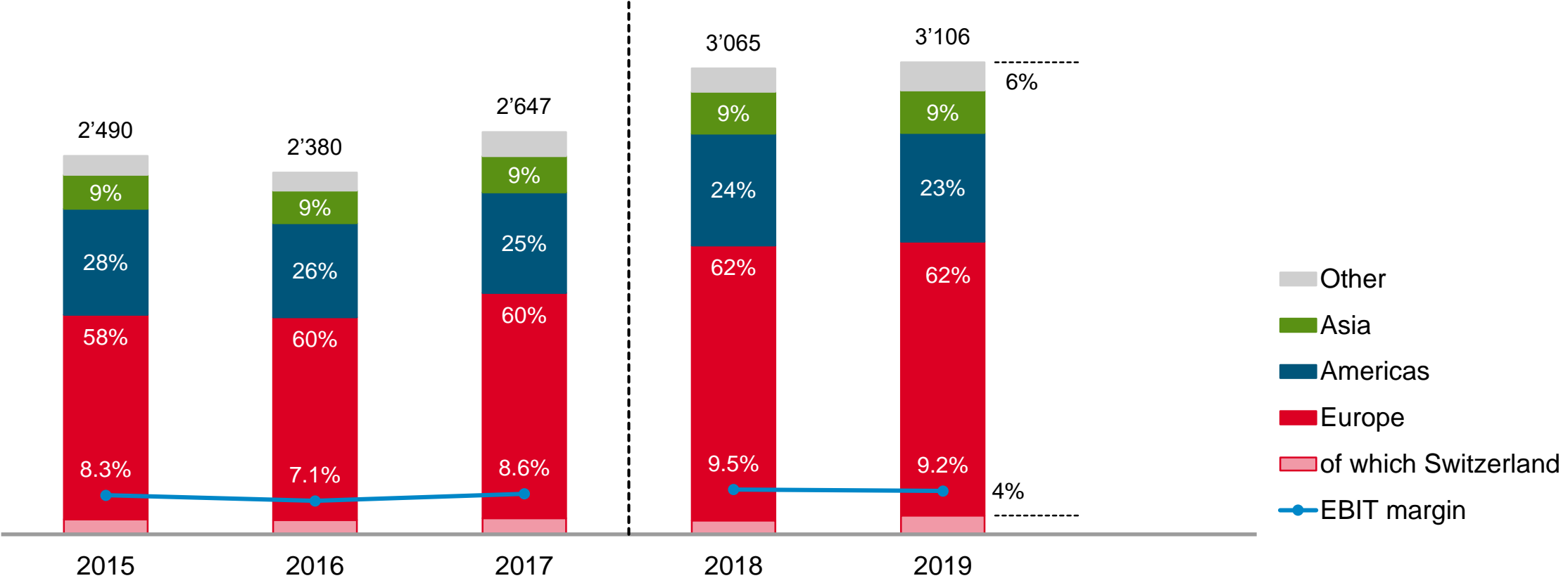

Good result despite lower demand

Group: 2019 at a glance

Slight 1% increase in sales over the excellent previous year, operating profit margin of 9.2% fell slightly short of the 2018 level

- **Kuhn Group:** Difficult situation in the North American market, sales and operating profit margin slightly lower than in the previous year
- **Bucher Municipal:** Sales at the same high level as previous year despite weaker demand
- **Bucher Hydraulics:** Sharp drop in demand after exceptionally dynamic previous year, slight increase in sales
- **Bucher Emhart Glass:** Trend toward increased use of glass containers, sales and operating profit reached record high
- **Bucher Specials:** Challenges for Bucher Unipektin, positive development in the other business units

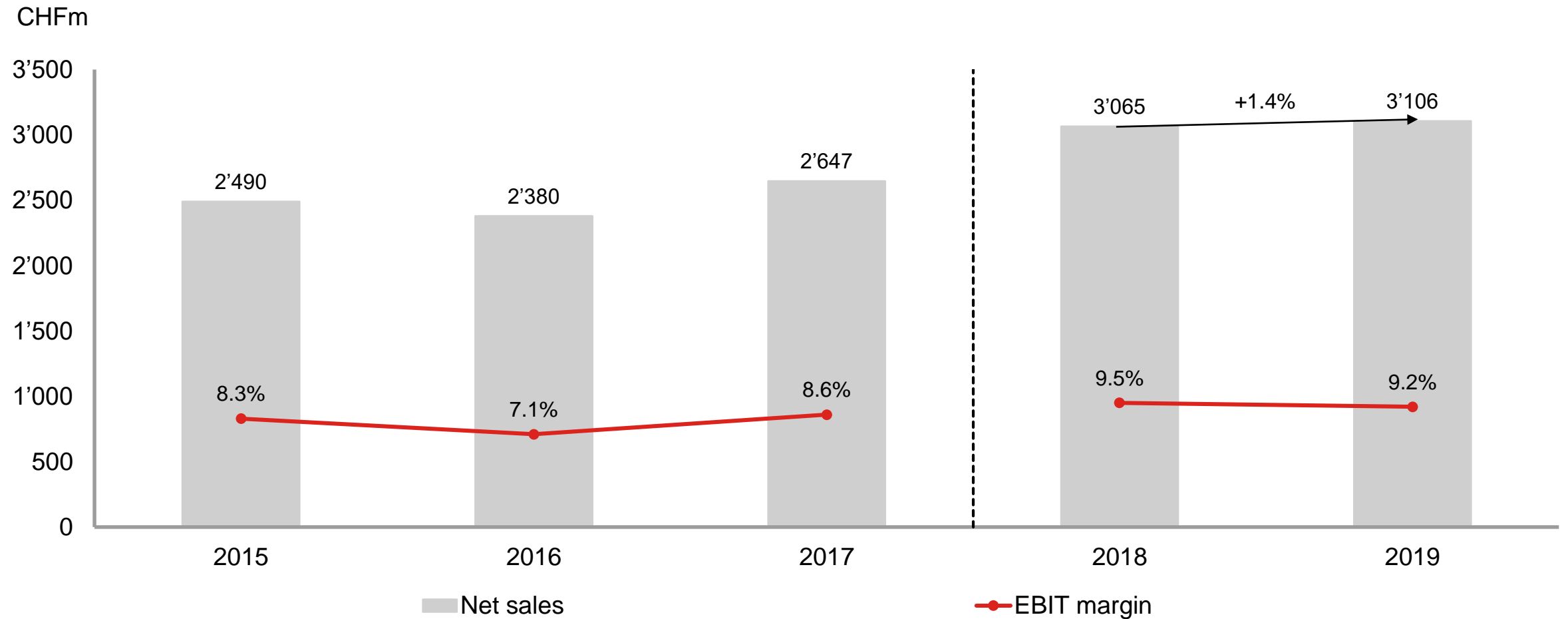

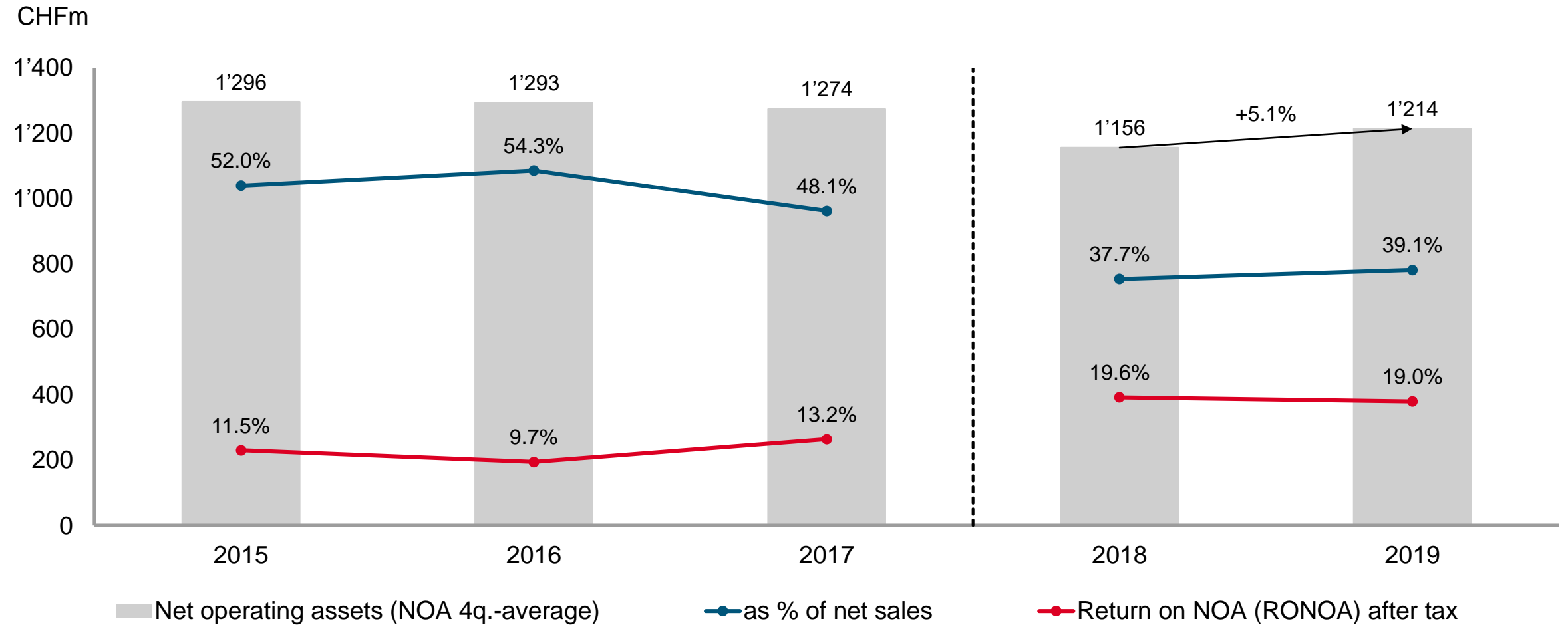

Performance: Net sales and EBIT margin



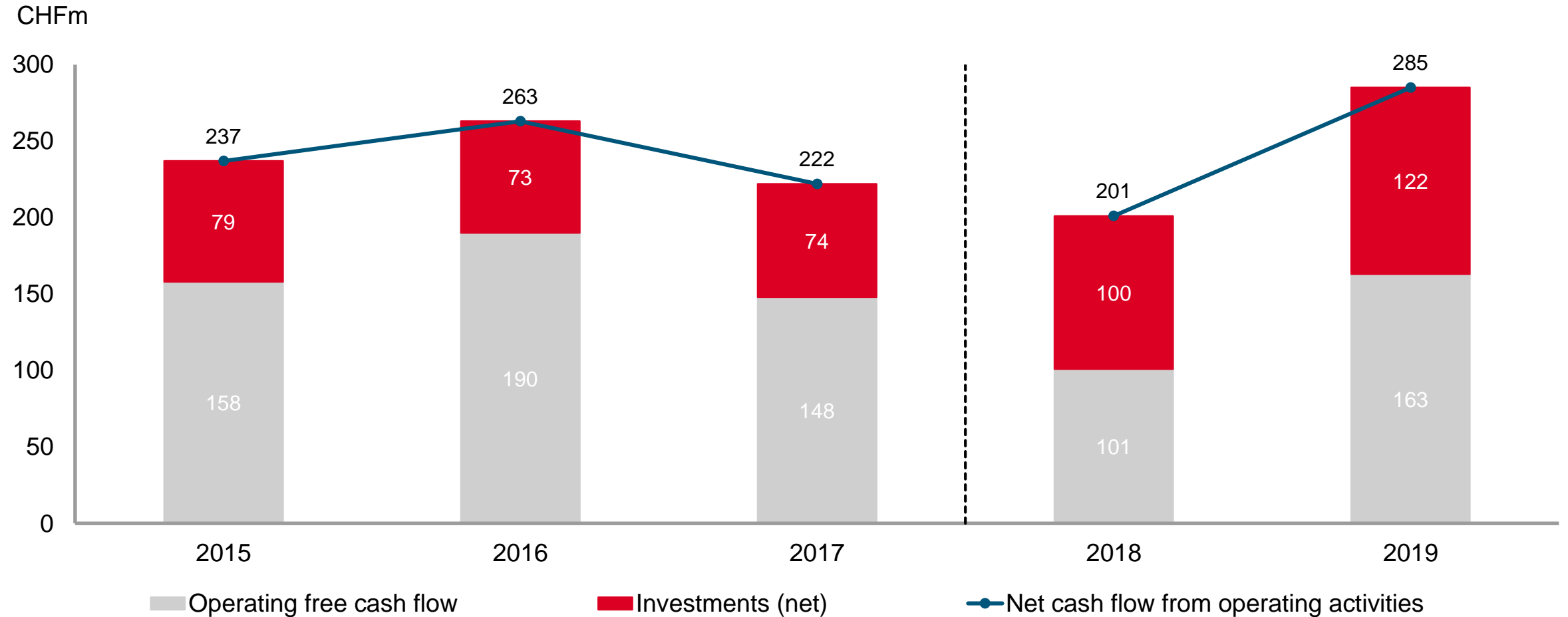
Increase in NOA in percentage of sales

Invested capital: Net operating assets (NOA)



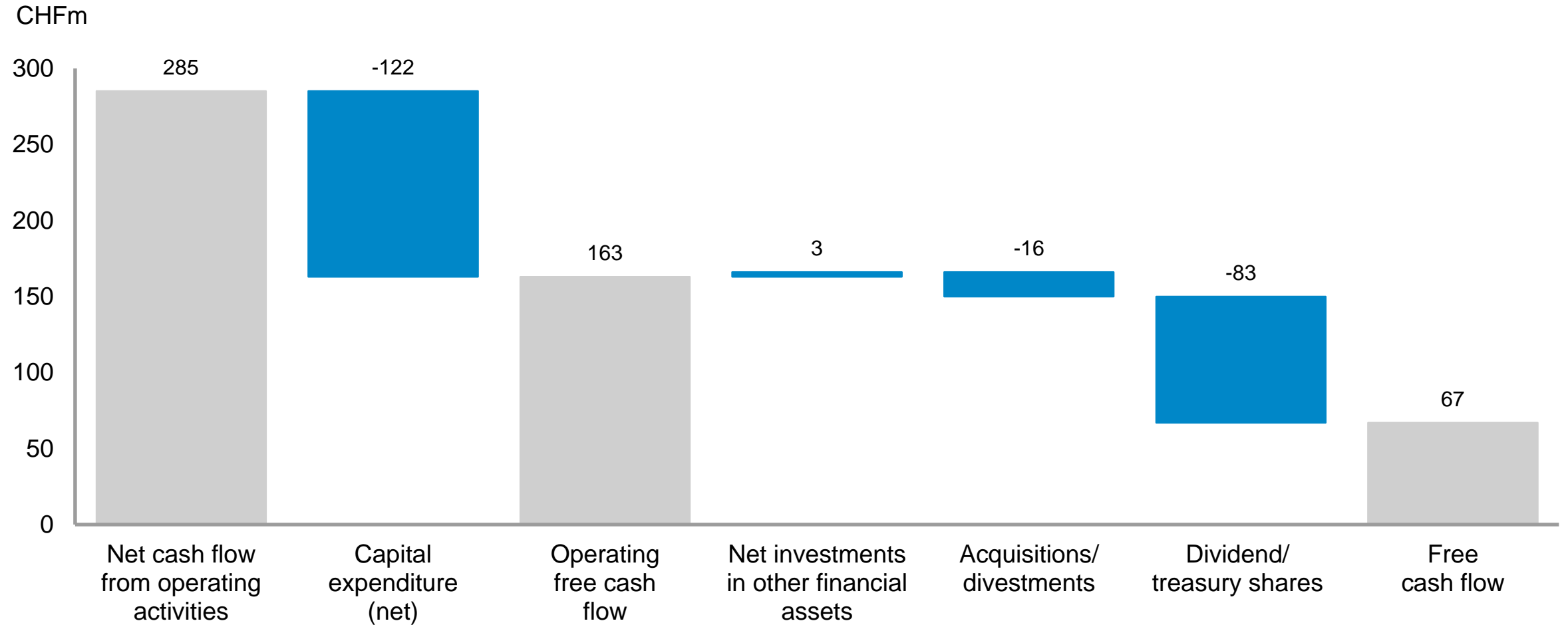

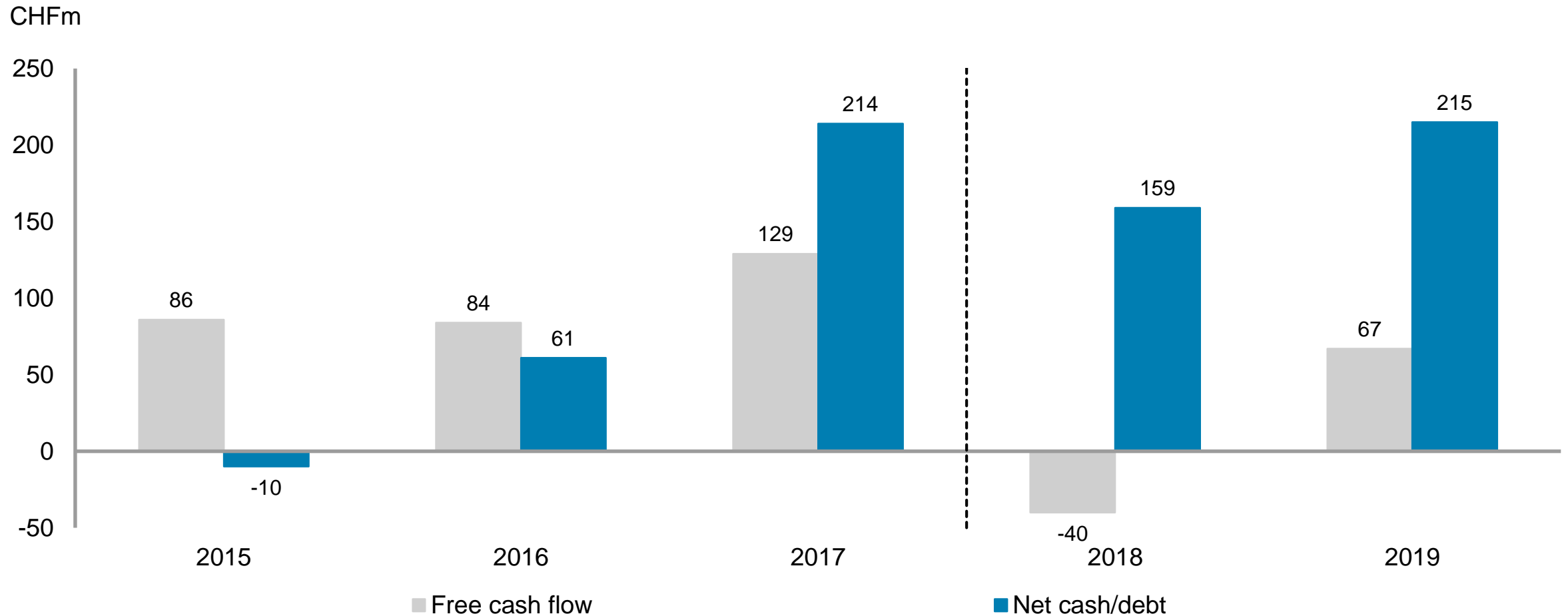

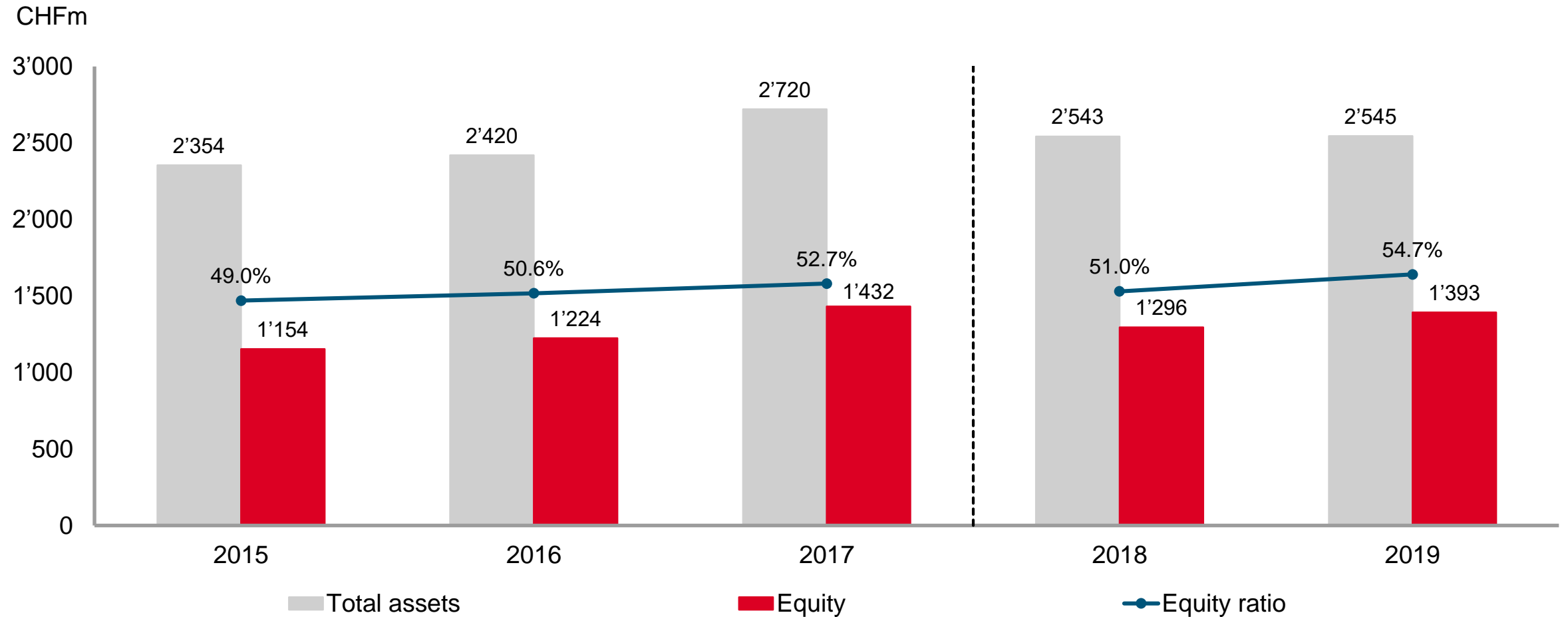

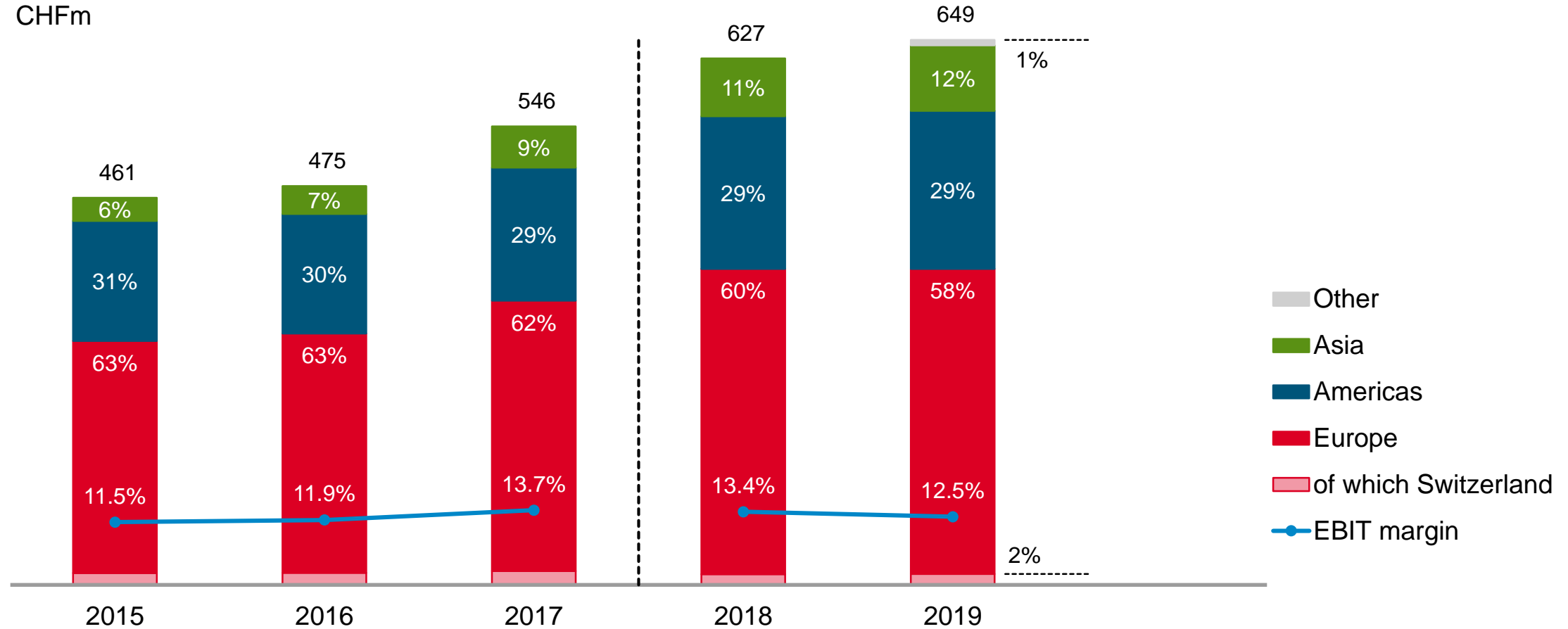

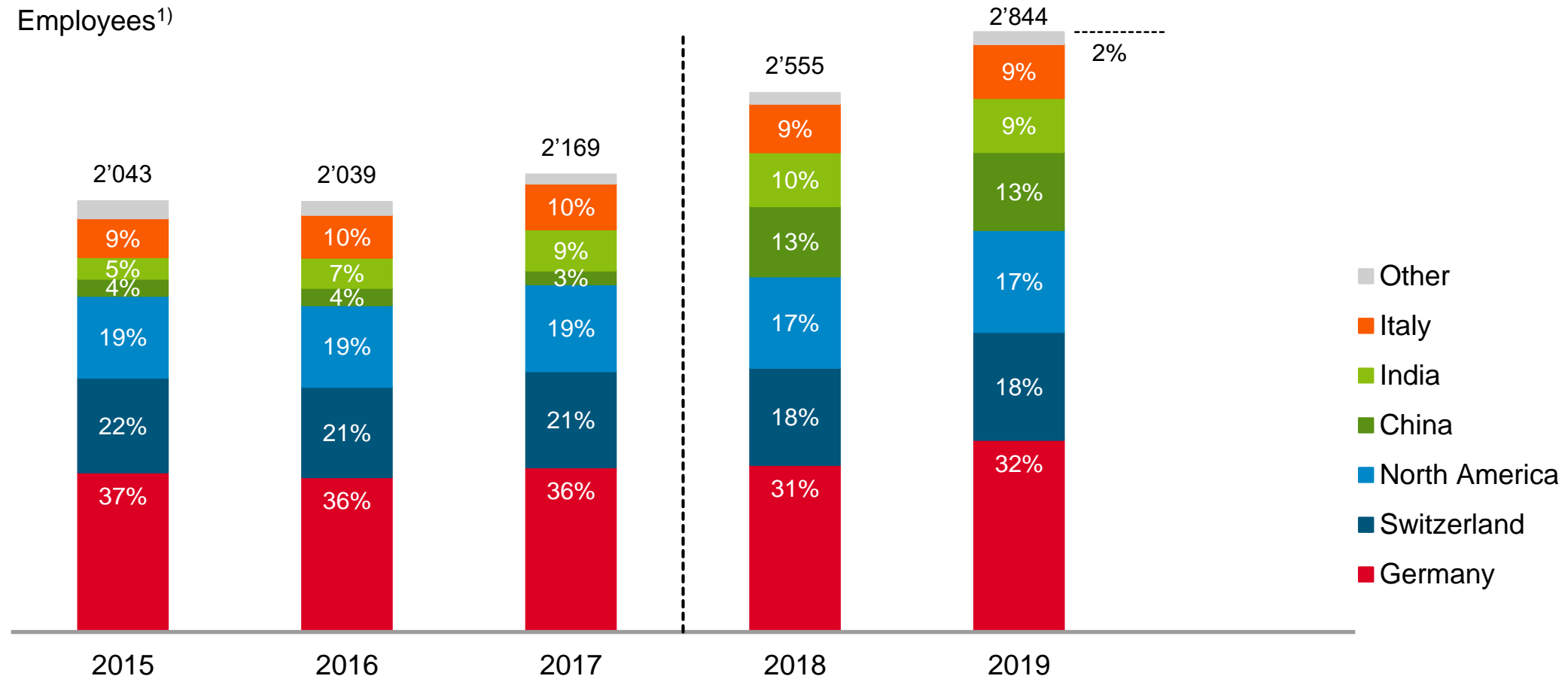

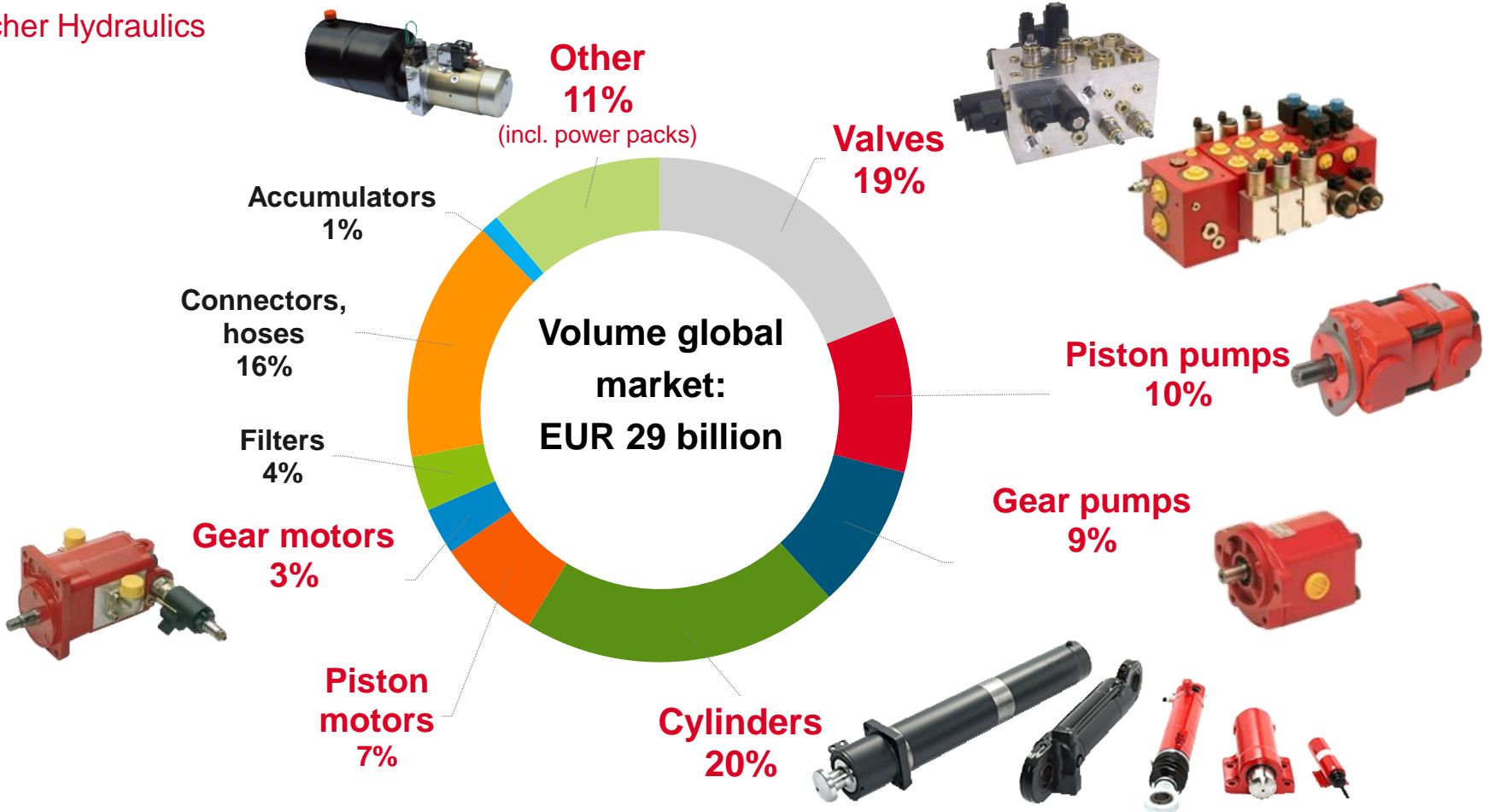

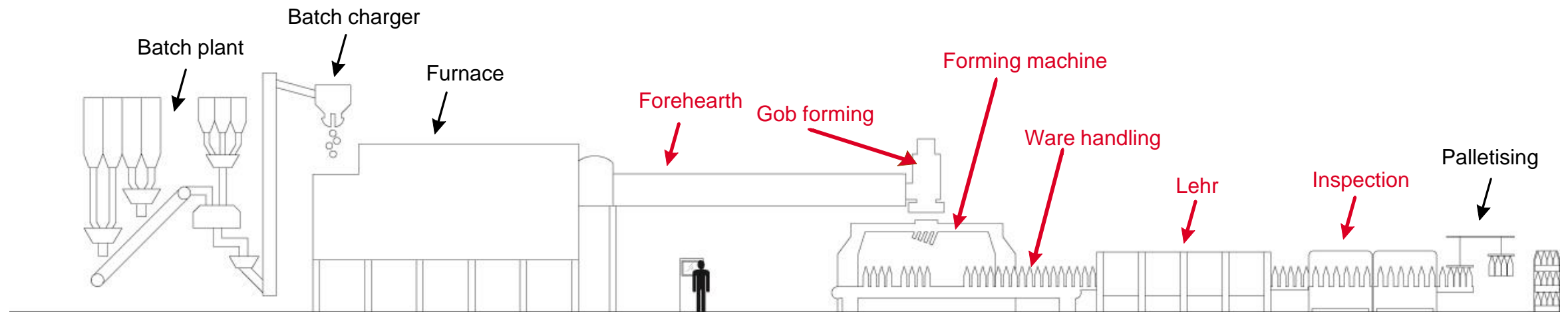

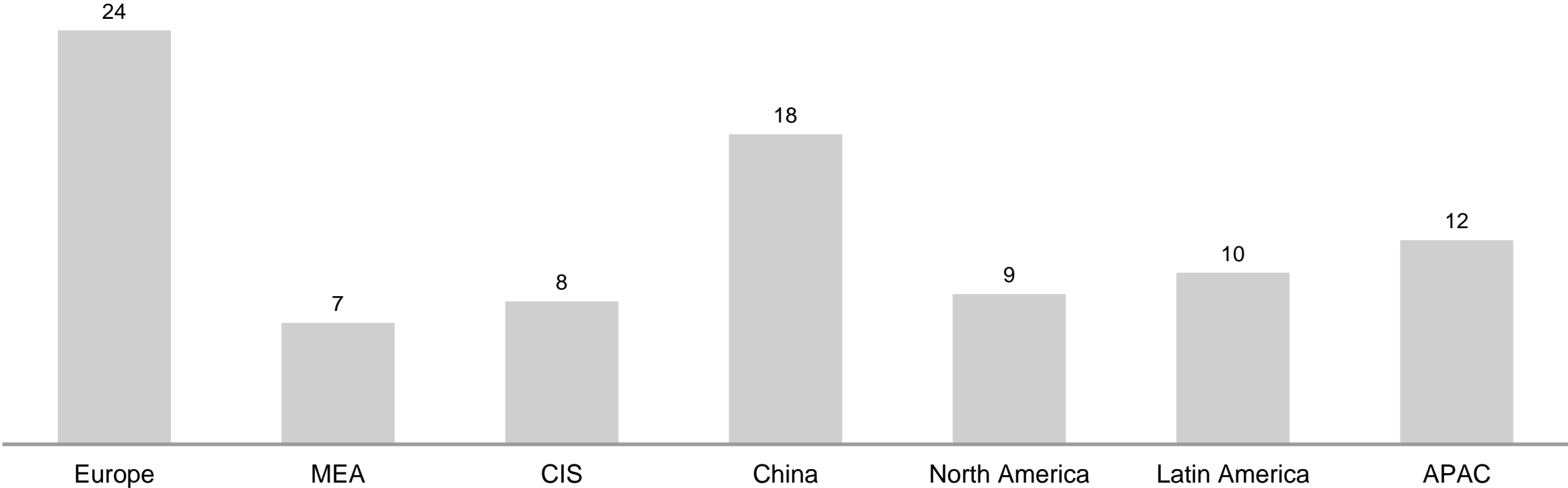

- Jetter: Sales growth, high demand from glass container industry

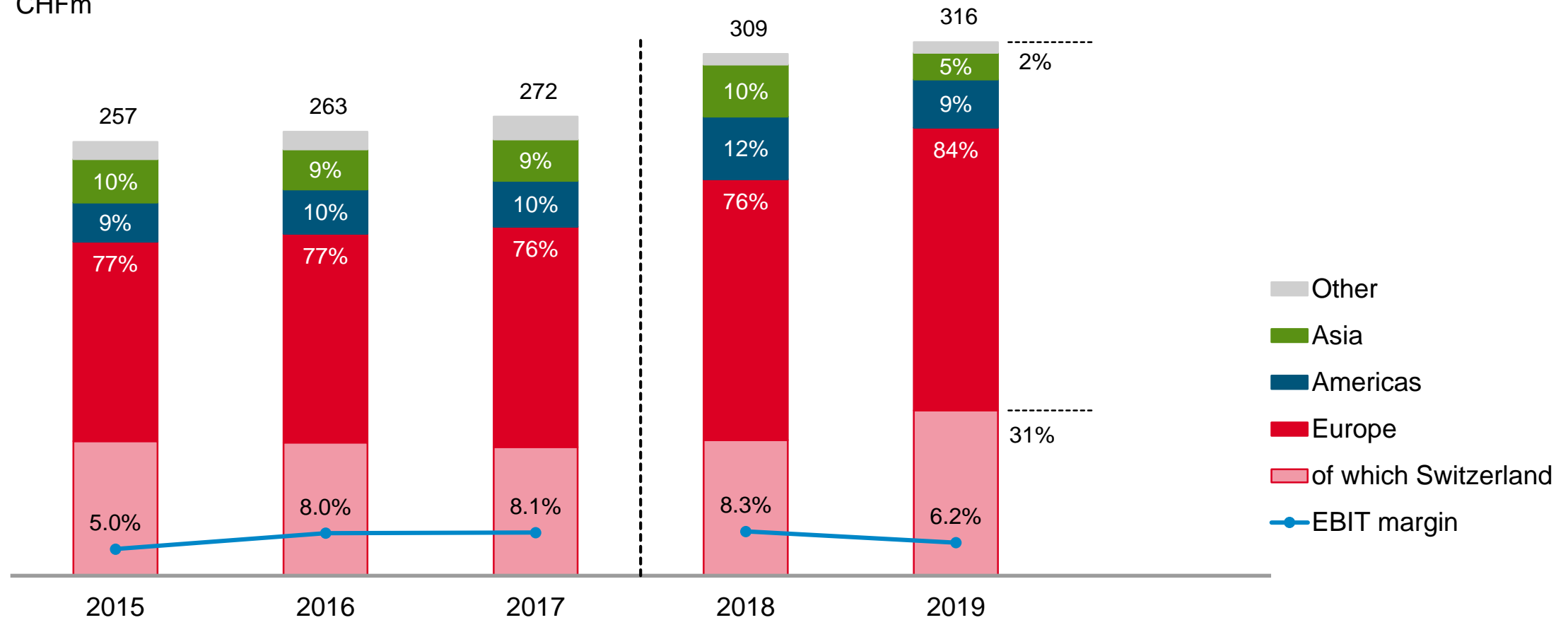

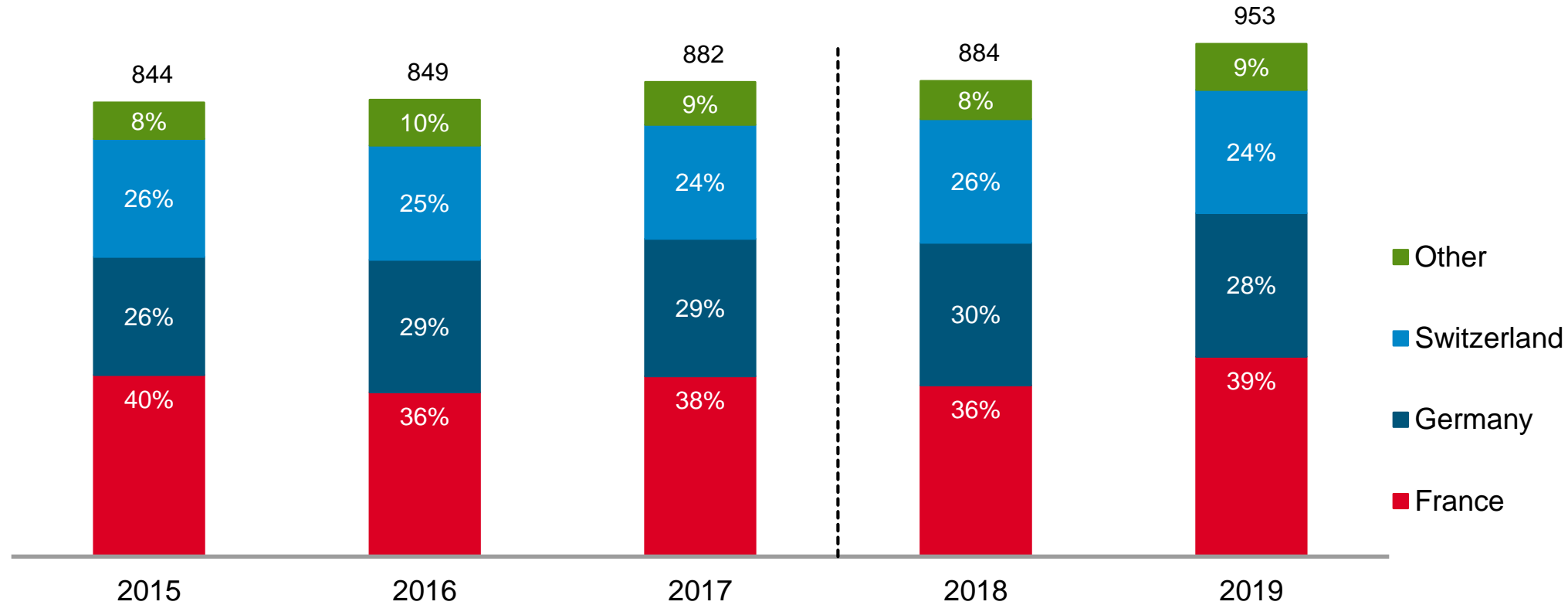

COVID-19 exacerbates farmers' situation

Kuhn Group: Outlook for 2020

Regionally divergent environment, but overall continued pressure on agricultural producers' incomes

- North America: Additional pressure on producer prices – also for dairy and meat – due to COVID-19
- Europe: Pandemic adds to existing challenges posed by lower prices for arable crop products and the uncertainties surrounding future agricultural policies
- Brazil: Good market situation thanks to the favourable conditions for farmers

Strategic focus

- Large machines for large farms
- Digital solutions for precision farming and customer retention
- Close to customers: Distribution centres in Brazil and Russia

For 2020: Decline in sales in line with the first six months; operating profit margin lower than in the first half of the year, due to seasonal effects

Improved market climate for the remainder of the year

Bucher Municipal: Outlook for 2020

Resuming activities in the second half of the year

- Easing of restrictions by authorities in important markets
- Supply chain largely working again

Strategic projects

- “One company – one brand”
- Launch of new electric compact sweeper “CityCat V20e”
- Integration of Eurovoirie
- Greater efficiency due to modularisation

For 2020: Sales to recover in the second half compared to the first six months of the year; operating profit margin in the mid-single-digit range

Gradual stabilisation of hydraulics market

Bucher Hydraulics: Outlook for 2020

Lower business volume due to reductions and closures among machinery manufacturers

- Gradual recovery in the further course of the year, but demand below the prior-year level
- Early measures and flexible cost structure help to adapt to lower capacity utilisation

Investments in the future

- Development of innovative AX axial piston line, particularly suitable for electrified machines
- Increasing focus on electrohydraulics
- Ongoing expansion of the product line in the lower price segment

For 2020: Sales decline comparable to that in the first half of the year; operating profit margin nonetheless in the high-single-digit range

Only very slow recovery of demand

Bucher Emhart Glass: Outlook for 2020

Cautiousness amongst glass container manufacturers to expand and modernise their production lines

- In general more repairs of existing installations
- Further capacity adaptation and reduction of headcount in China
- Partial reopening of borders allows negotiation of major projects and installation of equipment to be resumed

Further strengthening of market position

- Construction of first complete “End to End” production lines
- Expansion of services, e.g. “Training on glass”

For 2020: Recovery of sales in the second half of the year compared with the first half thanks to good order book; operating profit margin in line with first six months

High levels of uncertainty in beverage industry

Bucher Specials: Outlook for 2020

Dominated by project postponements and a low order book at mid-year

- Bucher Vaslin: Lower investments in the main markets of France, Italy, Spain and the USA due to suspension of restaurants' business and sales directly from cellars
- Bucher Unipektin: Project postponements by customers
- Bucher Landtechnik: Continuously solid development despite the uncertainties regarding agricultural policy and certain difficulties with suppliers
- Jetter: Demand continues to be on a lower level, impacted by the development at Bucher Emhart Glass

For 2020: Marked decline in sales compared to 2019; operating profit margin positive, thanks to various cost-savings initiatives

Gradual recovery of business performance

Group: Outlook for 2020

High uncertainties and severely limited visibility due to COVID-19

- **Kuhn Group:** Decline in sales in line with the first six months; operating profit margin lower than in the first half of the year, due to seasonal effects
- **Bucher Municipal:** Sales to recover in the second half compared to the first six months of the year; operating profit margin in the mid-single-digit range
- **Bucher Hydraulics:** Sales decline comparable to that in the first half of the year; operating profit margin nonetheless in the high-single-digit range
- **Bucher Emhart Glass:** Recovery of sales in the second half of the year compared with the first half thanks to good order book; operating profit margin in line with first six months
- **Bucher Specials:** Marked decline in sales compared to 2019; operating profit margin positive, thanks to various cost-savings initiatives
